OUR TOTAL PROGRAM ATTENDANCE REACHED AN ALL-TIME HIGH, AND WE ENGAGED A RECORD NUMBER OF CHILDREN AND TEENS IN THE SUMMER READING PROGRAM. WE INTRODUCED NEW INITIATIVES TO HELP IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES ACCESS LEGAL SERVICES AND GAIN CITIZENSHIP, AND PARTNERED WITH THE MAYOR'S OFFICE TO OPEN AN IDNYC REGISTRATION POINT AT OUR CENTRAL LIBRARY. IN FISCAL YEAR 2016, BPL WILL EXPAND OUR EARLY CHILDHOOD LITERACY PROGRAMMING, IMPROVE ACCESS TO DIGITAL RESOURCES, AND REDESIGN OUR PUBLIC WEBSITE.

BROOKLYN PUBLIC LIBRARY ALSO RECENTLY LAUNCHED TWO NEW PROGRAMS-TELESTORY AND DADDY/MOMMY & ME. THE TELESTORY PROGRAM UTILIZES VIDEO CONFERENCING TECHNOLOGY AT CENTRAL AND RIKERS ISLAND TO FACILITATE STORY TIMES, SING-ALONGS AND OTHER BONDING ACTIVITIES FOR INCARCERATED PARENTS AND CHILDREN. UNIQUE AMONG U.S. LIBRARIES, THE TELESTORY PROGRAM BRIDGES FORMIDABLE BARRIERS TO UNITE FAMILIES WHO MIGHT OTHERWISE BE SEPARATED. IN FY15, THE TELESTORY PROGRAM HAS COMPLETED 68 SUCCESSFUL TELEVISITS AVERAGING THREE A MONTH AND SOMETIMES REACHING A HIGH OF 12 A MONTH. PARTICIPANTS WHO COMPLETE THE DADDY/MOMMY & ME SERIES ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TELESTORY PROGRAM. A TOTAL OF 11 DADDY/MOMMY & ME PROGRAMS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED IN FY15.
